Before sending your application by mail, please make sure that the application form is complete and signed and all required documents are attached. For list of required documents please refer to the relevant section below.

Please note all those documents which require to be notarized must be signed by a <u>Notary</u> <u>Public</u> or a <u>Lawyer</u> and <u>not by a Commissioner for Oaths</u>. Only Affidavits could be signed by Oath Commissioners.

Search Instructions:

Important Notes

- Fee is nonrefundable for all services.
- Emergency Passport (Travel Document) is valid for limited duration of not more than 7 days.
- Travel itinerary/booking is required. Verification is required before your application can be processed. The verification will be pursued from our office. Once verification has been received our office would contact you for an itinerary.
- The emergency travel document is not a passport and therefore can only be used for entry into Pakistan. After successful entry into Pakistan your travel document will expire.

Emergency Passport (Travel Document)

Persons eligible for issuance of emergency passport (travel document):

 Emergency Passport (Travel Document) are only issued for cases of deportation from Canada. Only those who are being deported from Canada can apply.
You have all the requirements listed below in the requirements section.
You are within our service area of Alberta, British Columbia, Saskatchewan and Yukon and Northwest Territories.
Toronto services Ontario residents except Ottawa Montreal services any other provinces not listed above

Requirements following listed #1-9 are required with your application:

1) Duly filled in Emergency Travel Document Form

Thumb impression must be done in black ink or blue ink.

2) Copy of travel itinerary/booking is required.

Our office will contact you for an itinerary after receiving verification. Information from the travel itinerary will be recorded in the passport.

- **3)** Photocopy of any letter/s issued from Canadian government requesting mandatory removal from Canada and any other relevant letters must be provided.
- 4) Original expired or soon to be expired manual or machine read-able passport along with copies of first four pages.
- 5) Original valid CNIC or valid NICOP along with a photocopy.

For children below the age of 18 years and not having NICOP, please attach original Children Registration Certificate (CRC) along with a photocopy.

If you do not wish to not send your original identification you may send us the original notarized copy.

Your identification must be notarized by a notary public or lawyer.

If CNIC/NICOP is expired applicant may provide the expired in original along with a photocopy and we will review your case.

- 6) Original valid Canadian status (photocopy and original) any one of the following:
 - PR-Card

- Canadian Passport
- Canadian Citizenship Card / Certificate
- Canadian Birth Certificate
- Study / Work Visa

If you do not wish to not send your original identification you may send us the original notarized copy.

Your identification must be notarized by a notary public or lawyer.

If Canadian status is expired applicant may provide the expired in original along with a photocopy and we will review your case.

7) Two colour photographs are required.

Instructions:

- Photograph must be duly stamped with the date by a photographer in Canada.
- Photograph must be taken within the past three months.
- The size of the photo to be submitted is 1.5" width by 2.0" height with a light blue or white background.
- 8) Applicants sending their documents through mail should invariably enclose a selfaddressed registered pre-paid return envelope with their application.

Applicants are requested to note down the incoming and outgoing tracking # with the courier service in case package confirmation is required.
